**ORDER NO. 6**  
**FINDING APPLICATION, AS SUPPLEMENTED, COMPLETE,**  
**REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the July 14, 2021 application filed by Bastrop West Water Supply (Bastrop West) and K&K Water Company (K & K Water) (collectively, applicants) for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Bastrop County. On July 27, August 11, 27, and 31, September 3, and October 25, 2021, the applicants filed supplemental information to the application. On January 7, 2022, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation regarding the completeness of the application.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner described in and attached to the memorandum of Jolie Mathis dated January 7, 2022, using the included forms.

The ALJ establishes the following schedule for further processing:
