**COMMISSION STAFF’S MOTION FOR AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On July 14, 2021, Bastrop West Water Supply (Bastrop West) and K & K Water Company (K & K Water) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for approval for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Bastrop County. The Applicants seek approval to sell and transfer all of Bastrop West’s facilities and certificated service area under water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12050 to K & K Water’s water CCN No. 11836. The requested area consists of approximately 289 acres and 117 customer connections. The Applicants filed supplemental information on July 27, 2021 and August 11, 2021 and October 25, 2021.

On January 10, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 6, establishing a deadline of February 17, 2022 for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

**I. REQUEST FOR AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

Commission Staff requests that its deadline to file its recommendation on sufficiency of notice be extended to February 25, 2022. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), Commission Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. The Applicants filed additional information in the docket on February 17, 2022 and Commission Staff has not had time to take into account the additional information. Accordingly, Commission Staff needs additional time to review the supplemental information.

## **II. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

Therefore, Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:
