ORDER NO. 8
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING
SCHEDULE FOR CONTINUED PROCESSING

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Bastrop West Water Supply and K & K Water Company. On February 22, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of notice. On February 2, 2022, the applicants filed a notice affidavit and supplemental information on February 17, 2022. Notice was mailed to current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on February 1 and 17, 2022, which included the parties listed in Commission Staff's recommendation on administrative completeness filed on January 7, 2022, along with the map of the affected area.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the notice, as supplemented, sufficient.

Deadline for parties to file a response to Commission Staff's recommendation. If no response is filed, deadline for the parties and Commission Staff to file joint proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs.	May 16, 2022
120-day deadline for the Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	June 17, 2022

¹ Because the deadline to intervene falls on Saturday, March 19, 2022, the deadline moves to the next day the Commission is open for business, Monday, March 21, 2022, in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.239(b).
