**ORDER NO. 14**  
**FINDING CLOSING DOCUMENTATION SUFFICIENT**  
**AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the closing documentation filed by Bastrop West Water Supply and K & K Water Company on August 29, 2022. The closing documents include an executed bill of sale, dated August 29, 2022, signed by representatives of the transferor, Bastrop West Water, and the transferee, K & K Water, along with a description of the property, assets, and facilities. Additionally, because the application represents that there are no customers with deposits, the customer deposits have been adequately addressed.

On September 28, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of the closing documentation.


The administrative law judge finds the closing documentation sufficient.
