**TXU LSEs’ AND LUMINANT ENERGY’S MOTION TO CONDITIONALLY
ACCELERATE THE START OF THE HEARING ON THE MERITS**

TXU Energy Retail Company LLC (TXU Energy), Ambit Texas, LLC (Ambit), Luminant ET Services Company LLC (ETS), TriEagle Energy LP (TriEagle), and Value Based Brands LLC dba 4Change Energy, Express Energy, and Veteran Energy (VBB) (collectively, the TXU load-serving entities or TXU LSEs) and Luminant Energy Company LLC (Luminant Energy) respectfully ask Your Honor to conditionally start the hearing on the merits on August 24, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. to maximize the time allotted to each party.


Pursuant to the procedural schedule established in Order No. 4, filed August 5, 2021, the hearing on the merits is scheduled to begin on August 24, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. Pursuant to Order No. 4 issued in Docket No. 52321 on August 5, 2021 the hearing on the merits in that docket is currently scheduled to begin on August 23, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. and, if the hearing is not concluded on August 23, 2021, will be continued on August 24, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. It may be reasonable to expect that the hearing on the merits in Docket No. 52321 will conclude on August 23, 2021. If that occurs, parties to Docket No. 52322 would be benefitted by re-allocating the morning hours of August 24th to use as additional hearing time in this Docket.

The parties that agree with, or do not oppose, this request include: Public Utility Commission of Texas Staff, Electric Reliability Council of Texas, Inc., Just Energy Texas, LP, AP Gas & Electric (TX), LLC, Southern Federal Power LLC, Lower Colorado River Authority, Calpine Corporation, The City of Austin d/b/a Austin Energy, Exelon Generation Company, LLC, Texas Industrial Energy Consumers, and NRG Energy, Inc.

For the reasons stated above, the TXU LSEs and Luminant Energy move to reschedule the hearing on the merits in this proceeding to start at 9:00 a.m. on August 24, 2021 if the hearing on the merits in Docket No. 52321 concludes on August 23, 2021.
