**COMMISSION STAFF’S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

On July 14, 2021, Manvel Terrace Utilities, Inc. (Manvel Terrace) and the Southwest Environmental Resources (Southwest) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Fort Bend County. Specifically, Manvel Terrace seeks approval to acquire facilities and to transfer water service area held under Southwest’s Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) Number 11648. Applicants filed supplemental information on August 3, 2021 August 13, 2021, September 21, 2021, September 22, 2021, and October 12, 2021.

On August 20, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 2, establishing a deadline of October 15, 2021 for the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff) to file comments on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice and to propose a procedural schedule for the further processing of this docket. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

**I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Applicants filed supplemental mapping information on October 12, 2021. Staff required additional time to review the new information. Accordingly, Staff requests that the deadline to file comments on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice and to propose a procedural schedule for the further processing of this docket be extended to November 15, 2021. Applicants are unopposed to Staff’s request for extension.

**II. CONCLUSION**

Staff respectfully requests an order consistent with the foregoing request.
