**ORDER NO. 5
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Southwest Environmental Resources and Manvel Terrace Utilities, Inc., regarding the application for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Fort Bend County.

On December 18, 2021, the applicants filed the affidavit of Harrison Williams, president of Manvel Terrace, attesting that notice was mailed to current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on December 3, 2021. Attached to the affidavit were copies of the notice and map provided by the applicants.

On December 29, 2021, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on the sufficiency of the notice.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket:

¹ Under 16 TAC § 24.239(a) and (i), the deadline for Commission action is 120 days after the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later. The 120-day deadline falls on Saturday, April 2, 2022; therefore, the deadline rolls over to April 4, 2022, the next day the agency is open for business.
