**ORDER NO. 2  
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,  
ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE, AND DENYING REQUEST FOR  
EXTENSION**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the July 14, 2021 application of Southwest Environmental Resources and Manvel Terrace Utilities, Inc. for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Fort Bend County.

The administrative law judge finds the application administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before September 15, 2021, the applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the August 16, 2021 memorandum of Patricia Garcia. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicants must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

On or before October 15, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
