# JOINT PROPOSED CORRECTION TO THE PROPOSED ORDER

The Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas has reviewed the memorandum filed by the administrative law judge (ALJ) on March 8, 2022, along with the attached proposed order. The memorandum established a deadline of March 22, 2022, for Staff and Mark Patterson (collectively, the Parties) to file corrections or exceptions. The Parties have reviewed the proposed order and identified a possible correction. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

# I. PROPOSED CORRECTION

The Parties propose the following correction:

Modify ordering paragraph number five to indicate that the temporary rates approved in this order will carry forward to the new owner purchasing the Horseshoe Bend system in Docket No. 50085 for a reasonable period to be determined in that docket:

1. The temporary rates approved in this Order will remain in place until the transaction in Docket No. 50085 receives final approval from the Commission, and until temporary rates for the new owner of the system are established in Docket No. 50085 to remain in place for a reasonable time period to be determined by the Commission when that docket is finalized.

#### II. CONCLUSION

The Parties respectfully request the adoption of the correction proposed above.
