MOTION TO INTERVENE**

Southern Federal Power LLC (“Southern Federal Power”)<sup>1</sup> files this Motion to Intervene and respectfully requests that Southern Federal Power be granted party status in this proceeding.

**I.**

Southern Federal Power seeks to participate in the above-captioned proceeding pursuant to Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “PUC”) PROC. R. 22.103 and 22.104. Southern Federal Power is a retail electric provider (“REP”) certificated by the Commission to provide retail electric service in regions of Texas within the Electric Reliability Council of Texas (“ERCOT”) and is a load-serving entity (“LSE”) and wholesale market participant that will be required to submit documentation in this docket as consistent with the Debt Obligation Order contemplated to be issued in Docket 52322. Therefore, Southern Federal Power has a justiciable interest that may be adversely affected by the outcome of this proceeding and should be granted party status.
