Calpine Corporation, on its own and on behalf of its wholly owned subsidiaries that serve retail customers, moves to intervene in the above-styled proceeding pursuant to the Public Utility Regulatory Act ("PURA"), Tex. 

Calpine is the upstream corporate owner of retail electric providers (“REPs”) and several Qualified Scheduling Entities (“QSEs”) and sub-QSEs that together participate in the ERCOT retail market to serve retail customers. Calpine's REPs are Load Serving Entities ("LSEs") that provide retail electric service to customers in the areas of state that are open to retail competition. LSEs, such as those owned by Calpine, will be required under PURA § 39.653 to submit documentation of exposure to certain Winter Storm Uri costs, and to document the opt-out choice of opt-out eligible entities they serve, in this docket consistent with the debt obligation order to be issued in Docket No. 52322. Calpine, by virtue of its ownership of these REP and QSE entities, has standing to intervene in this proceeding under 16 TAC § 22.103(b) because their justiciable interests may be affected by the outcome of this proceeding. Calpine respectfully asks the administrative law judge to grant this motion to intervene and admit Calpine as an intervenor in this proceeding.


