EHU'S RESPONSE TO BARRY EVANS COMMENTS


East Houston Utilities, Inc. (EHU), Applicant, files this response to comments filed by Barry Evans in this docket on March 28, 2025. Mr. Evans is an EHU customer served by EHU's Whitewing Subdivision system. EHU has been working to implement the Commission's final order issued in this matter related to rates for that system since February 27, 2025, when the Commission issued that order. The comments filed by Mr. Evans relate to that implementation.

The Commission's order indicates that EHU's new tariff would be effective in place of EHU's previously effective interim rate tariff on the date of the order, February 27, 2025,¹ but EHU's billing period for the subject system ran from February 20, 2025, through March 20, 2025. Mr. Evans's most recent bill was for that billing period applicable to earlier water service.

EHU's has planned to implement its ordered rates beginning with the next billing cycle after February 27, 2025. However, to address Mr. Evans's concerns, EHU will refund the difference between the ordered rates and its previously effective interim rates as a bill credit on the next set of EHU Whitewing Subdivision system bills.


