ORDER NO. 8 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE SUFFICIENT, REQUIRING REVISED NOTICE, SUSPENDING EFFECTIVE DATE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the July 29, 2021 application by East Houston Utilities Inc. for authority to change water rates under Texas Water Code (TWC) §§ 13.1871 and 13.1872(c)(2). On September 21 and 24, October 13, and December 1, 2021, and January 26 and April 5, 2022, East Houston filed supplemental information. On April 29, 2022, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness of the application.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application, as supplemented, administratively complete.

Under TWC § 13.1871(g), East Houston's proposed effective date continues to be suspended.

On April 5, 2022, East Houston filed the affidavit of Hannah Krebs, records coordinator for East Houston, attesting that notice was mailed on April 25, 2022. Because the affidavit was executed and notarized prior to the date notice was allegedly provided, East Houston must, by May 13, 2022, file supplemental proof that revised notice was provided. By May 27, 2022, Commission Staff must file a recommendation on the sufficiency of the notice.

The ALJ establishes the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for East Houston to respond to Commission Staff's recommendation, or, of no disputed issues exist, deadline for parties to file proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs	June 3, 2022
Deadline for the Commission to set the matter for a hearing on its own motion (120 th day after the effective date) ²	September 29, 2022
