**RE:** **Sierra Club's Petition for Rulemaking**

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On August 10, 2022, the Lone Star Chapter of the Sierra Club filed a petition to initiate a rulemaking to amend 16 TAC §§ 25.181 (Energy Efficiency Goal) and 25.182 (Energy Efficiency Cost Recovery Factor). This petition will be processed in Project No. 53971.

Also related to the subject matter addressed in the Sierra Club's petition, Commission Staff is scheduled to host an Energy Efficiency Implementation Project meeting on Tuesday, October 18, 2022. The meeting will be held from 9:30 am to 3:30 pm in the Commissioners' Hearing Room located on the 7<sup>th</sup> floor of the William B. Travis Building.

- A stakeholder input "brainstorming" session for amendments (changes/improvements) to the Energy Efficiency Rule § 25.181, if opened, led by Oncor.
