**ORDER NO. 4  
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Liberty County Utilities. On November 29, 2021, Liberty County filed: (1) the affidavit of Shelly Young, Liberty Utilities' authorized representative, attesting that notice was mailed to neighboring systems, landowners, customers, and cities on November 8, 2021; and (2) a publisher's affidavit attesting that notice was published in *The Vindicator*, a newspaper of general circulation in Liberty County, on November 11 and 18, 2021. On January 10, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and adopts the following procedural schedule for continued processing:

If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	March 22, 2022
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	March 28, 2022
