**COMMISSION STAFF’S SECOND REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

On August 5, 2021, Liberty County Utilities, LLC (Liberty County) filed an application to obtain a water and sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Liberty County, Texas under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.254(a) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h). Liberty County filed supplemental information on August 6, 2021, October 5, 2021, October 6, 2021, and February 21, 2022, March 2, 2022, and March 30, 2022.

On March 23, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 5, establishing a deadline of April 5, 2022 for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a final recommendation on the application. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

**I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff requires additional information to make its final recommendation. After careful review, at this time Staff plans to file a second request for information which will require additional time to receive and review the response. Accordingly, Staff requests that the deadline to file a final recommendation on the application be extended to May 20, 2022.

**II. CONCLUSION**

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order extending Staff’s deadline to file its final recommendation on the application to May 20, 2022.
