**ORDER NO. 3
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, PROPOSED NOTICE SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the August 5, 2021 application of Liberty County Utilities, LLC to obtain water and sewer certificates of convenience and necessity in Liberty County. On August 6 and October 5 and 6, 2021, Liberty County filed supplements to the application. On November 8, 2021, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness, proposed notice, and proposed procedural schedule.


The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs Liberty County Utilities to provide notice of the application as described in the November 8, 2021 memorandum of Jolie Mathis and attached to Commission Staff's recommendation.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Liberty County Utilities to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	December 23, 2021
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of the notice	January 10, 2022
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
