## ORDER NO. 2 FINDING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

In this proceeding, Bryan Frenchak (the petitioner) seeks to amend Porter Municipal Utility District's water certificate of convenience and necessity in Montgomery County by expedited release. Commission Staff filed its recommendation on the administrative completeness of the petition on September 7, 2021.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the petition administratively incomplete, for the reasons described in Commission Staff's recommendation filed on September 7, 2021, and the memorandum of Jolie Mathis attached thereto.

By October 5, 2021, the petitioner must file information to cure the deficiencies. By November 2, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency of the petition and the sufficiency of notice, and propose a procedural schedule.
