ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the August 10, 2021 application of S. S. Water Supply Corporation and Las Palomas Water Service, LLC, under the receivership of Donald G. Rauschuber, for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights Wilson County.

The administrative law judge finds the application administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before September 23, 2021, the applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the September 9, 2021 memorandum of Patricia Garcia. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicants must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

On or before October 7, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
