FINDING NOTICE INSUFFICIENT AND
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of notice filed by Leon Springs Utility Company, Inc. and CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC on September 16, 2021, and filed confidential attachment as exhibit B on September 17, 2021.
