The sale is scheduled to take place if approved by the Commission (Texas Water Code § 13.301). The transaction and the transfer of the CCN includes the following subdivision: Dominion.

The requested area includes <u>1,209</u> customer connections, is located approximately <u>17</u> miles <u>north-northwest</u> of downtown <u>San Antonio</u>, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>Dominion Drive</u>; on the east by <u>Monterrey Road</u>; on the south by <u>Mission North Burial Park and Tejas Trail</u> West; and on the west by Union Pacific Railroad.

The requested area includes approximately <u>1,419</u> acres, comprised of <u>1,419</u> acres of transferred area (from CCN No. 20614).

The application proposes the addition of approximately 1,419 acres to CCN No. 21120.

This transaction will not have an effect on the current customer's rates and services.

The deadline for intervention in the proceeding is (30 days from the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later, unless otherwise provided by the presiding officer). You must send a letter Notice Form Updated: April 8, 2021

requesting intervention to the commission which is received by that date. The letter must include the person's name, address, email address and fax number if applicable.

If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.




