**ORDER NO. 5**  
**FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,**  
**REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the August 13, 2021 application of Patterson Water Supply LLC and Myra Water System for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Cooke County. The applicants filed supplemental information on December 16, 2021. On December 17, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the applications.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the applications, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner described in and attached to Patricia Garcia's memoranda dated December 17, 2021, using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:
