**ORDER NO. 11
REITERATING THE REQUIREMENT FOR MONTHLY STATUS REPORTS**

In Order No. 9 filed on April 14, 2022, the undersigned administrative law judge (ALJ) required Patterson Water Supply LLC and Myra Water System to file monthly reports regarding the status of the closing of the transaction and submission of documents evidencing that the transaction was consummated in an effort to finalize this proceeding as soon as possible. The first status report was due May 16, 2022. Both Patterson Water Supply and Myra Water System failed to make the mandatory filing.

In Order No. 10 filed on June 1, 2022, the ALJ established a deadline of June 14, 2022 for Patterson Water Supply and Myra Water System to submit a status report. Again, both Patterson Water Supply and Myra Water System failed to make the mandatory filing.

As of the date of this Order, no status reports have been filed.

By July 6, 2022, Patterson Water Supply and Myra Water System must submit a status report as described above. Thereafter, a status report must be filed every month as set out in Order No. 9.
