FINDING CLOSING DOCUMENTATION SUFFICIENT
AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the application of Patterson Water Supply LLC and Myra Water System for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Cooke County. The applicants filed closing documentation on July 1, August 12 and 18, and October 13, 2022.

On October 28, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of the closing documentation.

The administrative law judge finds the closing documentation sufficient.
