Docket No. 52434 – *Petition of Celina Partners, Ltd. to Amend Marilee Special Utility District's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity in Collin County by Expedited Release*

A proposed order in the above-referenced docket is posted for consideration and action by the Commission. If the Commission adopts the proposed order, I recommend the following change.

Proposed finding of fact 27 should be modified for accuracy.

27. The CCN holder owns and operates a six-inch waterline running through the ~~eastern~~western-most portion of the tract of land along County Road 132, but the waterline does not provide water service to the tract of land.

Additionally, the Commission should delegate to the Office of Policy and Docket Management the authority to modify the order to conform to the *Citation and Style Guide for the Public Utility Commission of Texas* and to make other non-substantive changes to the order for such matters as capitalization, spelling, grammar, punctuation, style, correction of numbering, and readability.
