PETITION OF LEGACY EQUESTRIAN CENTER LLC TO AMEND MARILEE SPECIAL UTILITY DISTRICT'S CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY IN COLLIN COUNTY BY EXPEDITED RELEASE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION

OF TEXAS

ORDER NO. 2 FINDING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE AND NOTICE SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the August 16, 2021 petition of Legacy Equestrian Center LLC to amend Marilee Special Utility District's water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 10150 in Collin County by expedited release.

I. Finding Application Administratively Complete

On September 14, 2021, Commission Staff recommended that the petition be found administratively complete. The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the petition administratively complete.

II. Notice

Legacy Equestrian's petition included an affidavit attesting that a copy of the petition was sent, via certified mail, to Marilee SUD on the date the petition was filed. The ALJ finds the notice sufficient.

III. Establishing Procedural Schedule

Under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541, the granting of streamlined expedited release initiates an appraisal process to determine the amount of monetary compensation that may be owed by the landowner to the certificate holder for the tract of land that was released. Therefore, an order granting approval for streamlined expedited release is interim in nature and, in the event the requested release is approved, the docket will continue for the purpose of determining the issue of compensation.
