**ORDER NO. 4**  
**GRANTING EXTENSION AND ABATEMENT OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's December 15, 2021, request for an extension and abatement of procedural schedule. Commission Staff requests additional time to compile the final documents that will be provided to Crystal Springs for review and consent. On November 10, 2021, Commission Staff filed its second request for information. Commission Staff cannot compile the final documents until Crystal Springs file responses to Commission Staff's second request for information.

The administrative law judge grants the extension and abates the procedural schedule established in Order No. 3 until Crystal Springs responds to Commission Staff's second request for information. Commission Staff must provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to Crystal Springs for review and consent 30 days after Crystal Springs files its responses to Commission Staff's second request for information.
