## ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, PROPOSED NOTICE SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the August 17, 2021 application of Crystal Springs Water Company, Inc. to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity in Montgomery County. On September 16, 2021 Commission Staff filed its recommendation on administrative completeness, proposed notice and proposed procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs the applicant to provide notice of the application as described in the September 16, 2021 memorandum of Patricia Garcia, and attached to Commission Staff's recommendation.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of the notice	November 11, 2021
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
