ORDER NO. 12 WITHDRAWING FINDING OF ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS, WITHDRAWING PROPOSED ORDER, AND GRANTING EXTENSION

In Order No. 5 filed on September 24, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) found the petition at issue in this matter to be administratively complete. In a Proposed Order filed on February 25, 2022, the ALJ recommended that the streamlined expedited release sought by Meritage Homes of Texas, LLC be granted.

On March 16, 2022, Meritage Homes disclosed that the mapping upon which its petition is based contains errors. On March 28, 2022, Meritage Home filed revised mapping. Commission Staff and Meritage Homes were given a deadline of April 28, 2022 to file corrections or exceptions to the Proposed Order. On April 27, 2022, Commission Staff requested new deadlines by which it could make: (a) a recommendation on the administrative completeness of corrected mapping filed by Meritage Homes; and (b) a new final recommendation on the application.

Because mapping discrepancies exist, the petition is no longer administratively complete and it is not ready for final determination. The administrative law judge (ALJ) withdraws the Proposed Order filed on February 25, 2022, and also withdraws the finding of administrative completeness in Order No. 5.

By May 13, 2022, Commission Staff must file a recommendation on the administrative completeness of the petition, along with a proposed procedural schedule for further processing of this petition.
