On February 25, 2022, I issued a proposed order in the above-referenced case.

On March 16, 2022, Meritage Homes of Texas, LLC disclosed that the mapping upon which its petition is based contains errors. On March 28, 2022, Meritage Homes filed revised mapping. Commission Staff and Meritage Homes were given a deadline of April 28, 2022 to file corrections or exceptions to the Proposed Order. On April 27, 2022, Commission Staff requested new deadlines by which it could make: (a) a recommendation on the administrative completeness of corrected mapping filed by Meritage Homes; and (b) a new final recommendation on the application.

Because mapping discrepancies exist, the petition is no longer administratively complete and it is not ready for final determination. The administrative law judge (ALJ) withdraws the Proposed Order filed on February 25, 2022.

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
