**COMMISSION STAFF’S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

On August 18, 2021, HydroTex, LLC (HydroTex) filed an application to obtain a water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) in Liberty County. The application requests a service area that includes 89 acres and 120 proposed connections.

On May 6, 2022, the administrative law judge filed Order No. 8 setting a deadline of July 5, 2022 for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission (Commission) to file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

**I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. On June 23, 2022, Hydrotex filed supplemental information. Staff requires more time to review Hydrotex’s filing. Thus, Staff respectfully requests an extension to July 27, 2022.

**II. CONCLUSION**

Staff respectfully requests that the deadline to provide its supplemental recommendation and a proposed procedural schedule be extended until July 27, 2022.
