FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ADDITIONAL NOTICE UNNECESSARY; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On March 13, 2023, HydroTex, LLC filed a pleading in which it stated that there are no landowners of a tract of land that is over 25 acres wholly or partly located in the requested area.

On March 28, 2023, Commission Staff filed a response to Order No. 13 and proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing.

In light of the above, the administrative law judge finds notice sufficient and no additional notice necessary.

The following procedural schedule is established for further processing:

Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificate, and tariff (if applicable) to HydroTex for review and consent	June 9, 2023
Deadline for HydroTex to file signed consent forms with the Commission	June 23, 2023
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	July 3, 2023
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs	July 14, 2023
