## ORDER NO. 3 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, PROPOSED NOTICE SUFFICIENT, ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE, AND RESTYLING DOCKET

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the August 20, 2021 application of Skyline Drive Landowners Association to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity number 12479 in Johnson County. On November 4, 2021, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on administrative completeness, proposed notice and proposed procedural schedule. Further, Commission Staff requested that the docket be restyled to accurately reflect that Skyline Drive Landowners seeks to amend its CCN by decertification under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.245(d)(2).

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs the applicant to provide notice of the application as described in the November 4, 2021 memorandum of Patricia Garcia, and attached to Commission Staff's recommendation.
