#### SOAH ORDER NO. 2 MEMORIALIZING PREHEARING CONFERENCE, REFERRING TO MEDIATION, ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE, AND SCHEDULING FINAL PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND HEARING ON THE MERITS

#### **I. PREHEARING CONFERENCE**

On December 10, 2021, Administrative Law Judges (ALJs) Linda H. Brite and Katerina DeAngelo of the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) held an initial prehearing conference in this case through the Zoom videoconferencing platform. An official record of the hearing was taken by Kennedy Reporting. Oncor Electric Delivery LLC (Oncor), the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), Chambers Creek Ranch LLC, and Lone Star Texas Land & Cattle Company LLC appeared. All appearances of the parties will be reflected in the official transcript. At the prehearing conference, the parties did not identify any issues with the service list.

#### **II. REFERRING TO MEDIATION**

The parties indicated that they were open to mediation and requested that the ALJs refer this case for mediation. **IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED:** 

1. This case is referred to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) Alternative Dispute Resolution Team Leader, ALJ Holly Vandrovec, for appointment of a mediator. With the issuance of this Order, the official file in this case is transferred to Judge Vandrovec for assignment of a mediator. The mediator will be contacting the parties directly.

- 2. The mediator will schedule a mediation in consultation with the parties.
- 3. The parties are ordered to appear at the mediation with a party representative who has full authority to settle this case on behalf of that party.
- 4. Should the mediation be unsuccessful, the case shall be returned to the undersigned ALJ.

## **III. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On December 6, 2021, Oncor submitted an Unopposed Proposed Procedural Schedule with the authorization to represent that all parties support or do not oppose the schedule. Accordingly, the ALJs adopt the following procedural schedule, which shall govern this case going forward:

# <u>Any intervenor who does not file direct testimony or a statement of position by the</u> <u>deadline set out above is subject to being stricken as a party under 16 Texas Administrative</u> Code §§ 22.124 and 22.161.

Additionally, the ALJs **ADOPT** the following special provision agreed to by the parties, which shall be in effect in this proceeding: for discovery on Intervenor Direct, Intervenor Cross-Rebuttal, and Applicant Rebuttal, responses are due within 10 calendar days of the discovery request and objections are due within five working days of the discovery request.

## IV. NOTICE OF FINAL PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND HEARING ON THE MERITS

It is **ORDERED** that **the final prehearing conference** will be convened via Zoom at **10:00 a.m. on April 8, 2022. The hearing on the merits** will convene via Zoom at **9:00 a.m. each day on April 11-13, 2022**. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic,<sup>1</sup> the ALJs will conduct the prehearing conference and the hearing on the merits via the Zoom videoconferencing platform.<sup>2</sup> The hearing on the merits is expected to last three days. Oncor shall be responsible for securing a court reporter to take a transcript of the proceeding, which will become the official record.

Attorneys' screen names should additionally identify the represented party (for example, "Ms. Garza–for Applicant"). Attorneys are responsible for providing their party representatives and witnesses with the same instructions.

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To participate via Zoom, you will need: (1) a computer with a functional webcam and microphone (preferred method); or (2) any mobile or smart device, such as a cellphone, iPad, iPhone, or Android phone; and (3) to have the latest version of Zoom installed (free installation).
