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**SOAH ORDER NO. 4  
GRANTING EXTENSION OF DEADLINE**

On February 15, 2022, Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC (Oncor) filed a Status Report and Request to Extend Procedural Deadline, indicating that the parties have reached an agreement in principle that will resolve all contested issues, contingent on an agreement addressing Texas Parks and Wildlife Department's (TPWD) recommendations. Oncor continues to coordinate with Public Utility Commission staff (Staff) and TPWD to finalize the terms of the agreement and requested that the deadline for intervenor testimony be extended to March 7, 2022. Oncor indicated that no parties have opposed this request. Under the circumstances, the Administrative Law Judges (ALJs) conclude the request should be granted.

The deadline for intervenors to file direct testimony or statement of position is **EXTENDED to March 7, 2022**. All other deadlines remain as set in SOAH Order No. 2, unless ordered by the ALJs.
