**ORDER REMANDING TO DOCKET MANAGEMENT**

This Order addresses the application of Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity for the Old Country Switch 345-kV tap transmission line in Ellis County. On March 31, 2022, the parties filed a unanimous agreement in favor of route 152, and on May 6, 2022, a proposed order was filed for the Commission's consideration. No testimony was admitted in support of the parties' unanimous agreement.

The Commission remands this proceeding to Docket Management for the parties to file testimony in support of the unanimous agreement so that the Commission can properly evaluate the merits of the parties' agreement. Specifically, the Commission requests testimony that justifies the cost of route 152 in light of the substantially lower cost of other routes (such as route 54), the reliability benefits of route 152 versus the other proposed routes, and all the other routing criteria that the Commission is required to consider under the applicable rule and statute, including the paralleling of existing compatible rights-of-way.
