FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Mountain Peak Special Utility District. On January 4, 2022, Mountain Peak SUD filed: (1) the affidavit of Randel Kirk, general manager of Mountain Peak SUD, attesting that notice was mailed to neighboring systems, landowners, customers, and cities on November 8, 2021; and (2) a publisher's affidavit attesting that notice was published in *Waxahachie Sun*, a newspaper of general circulation in Ellis and Johnson counties, on December 15 and 22, 2021. On January 19, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and adopts the following procedural schedule for continued processing:

If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	March 21, 2022
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	April 4, 2022
