## ORDER NO. 3 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE AND PROPOSED NOTICE SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the August 23, 2021 application of Mountain Peak Special Utility District to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity in Ellis and Johnson counties. Mountain Peak SUD filed supplemental information on October 25, 2021.

On November 23, 2021, Commission Staff filed its recommendations on administrative completeness and proposed notice, and proposed procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs the applicant to provide notice of the application as described in the November 23, 2021 memorandum of Jolie Mathis and attached to Commission Staff's recommendation.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for applicant to file with the Commission signed affidavits attesting that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	January 7, 2022
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of the notice	January 19, 2022
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
