**ORDER NO. 3**  
**FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by East Media Special Utility District and Creekwood Ranches Water Supply Corporation regarding the application for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Median County.

On October 11, 2021, the applicants filed an affidavit of notice to current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on October 6, 2021. The applicants filed the affidavit and a copy of the name and address of every person and entity to which notice and provided, the date notice was provided, accompanied by a map in the docket within 30 days of the date of notice.

On November 4, 2021, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on sufficiency of notice.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient.
