COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND NOTICE AND PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On August 24, 2021, East Medina Special Utility District (East Medina SUD) and Creekwood Ranches Water Supply Corporation (Creekwood Ranches WSC) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for approval of the sale and transfer of facilities and certificate rights in Medina County. Specifically, East Medina SUD, certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 10217, seeks approval to acquire facilities and to transfer all of the water service area from Creekwood Ranches WSC under water CCN No. 11897. The requested area includes 161 customer connections and approximately 355 acres, comprised of 355 acres of transferred area from CCN No. 11897. Applicants filed supplemental information on September 3, 2021.

On August 26, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 1, establishing a deadline of September 23, 2021 for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice, along with a proposed procedural schedule for the further processing of this docket. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

Staff has reviewed the application and supplemental information and, as detailed in the attached memoranda from Patricia Garcia, Infrastructure Division, and Kathryn Eiland and Fred Bednarski, III, Rate Regulation Division, recommend that the application is administratively complete. Staff's recommendation on administrative completeness is not a comment on the merits of the application.

II. NOTICE

At this time, Staff recommends that the Applicants proceed with providing public notice to all current customers, neighboring utilities, political subdivisions, and other persons listed in the attached memorandum using the notice form provided by Ms. Garcia. Along with each individual notice, Staff recommends that the Applicants provide an accurate map delineating the requested service area.

Once notice has been provided, Staff recommends that the Applicants file proof of notice as described in Ms. Garcia's attached memorandum, including an affidavit specifying the name and address of every person and entity to whom notice was provided, the date that the notice was provided, and a copy of the map provided with the notice. Finally, Staff recommends that the Applicants use the attached notice and affidavit to meet these requirements.

III. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff recommends that the application be found administratively complete. Therefore, Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:

IV. CONCLUSION

For the reasons detailed above, Staff recommends that the application be found administratively complete, that the Applicants be directed to provide notice as described in the attached memorandum, and that the proposed procedural schedule be adopted. Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with these recommendations.

On August 24, 2021, East Medina Special Utility District (East Medina SUD) and the Creekwood Ranches Water Supply Corporation (WSC) (collectively Applicants) filed an application for sale, transfer, or merger (STM) of facilities and certificate rights in Medina County, Texas, under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.301 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239.

Specifically, East Medina SUD, certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 10217, seeks approval to acquire facilities and to transfer all of the water service area from Creekwood Ranches WSC under water CCN No. 11897. The requested area includes 161 customer connections and approximately 355 acres, comprised of 355 acres of transferred area from CCN No. 11897.

The application proposes the transfer of approximately 355 acres from CCN No. 11897 to CCN No. 10217.

Based on the mapping review by Gary Horton, Infrastructure Division, the maps submitted on September 3, 2021 are sufficient. Based on my technical and managerial review of the additional information filed on September 3, 2021, I recommend that the application be deemed administratively complete. I further recommend that the Applicants be ordered to do the following:

- 1) Provide notice of the application by first-class mail to the following:
 - a. Cities, districts, and neighboring retail public utilities providing the same utility service whose corporate boundaries or certificated service area are located within two miles from the outer boundary of the requested area:

- Nueces River Authority
- Old Highway 90 Water Service (CCN No. 12975)
- Yancey WSC (CCN No. 11463)
- b. The county judge of each county that is wholly or partially included in the requested area:
 - Medina County Judge
- c. Each groundwater conservation district that is wholly or partially included in the requested area:
 - Edwards Aquifer Authority
 - Medina County Groundwater Conservation District
- d. Any affected customers, and other affected parties in the requested area.
