FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the August 24, 2021 application filed by East Medina Special Utility District and Creekwood Ranches Water Supply Corporation for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Medina County. The applicants filed supplemental information on September 3, 2021. On September 23, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the applications.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the applications, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner described in and attached to Patricia Garcia’s memoranda dated September 23, 2021, using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:
