**ORDER NO. 3**  
**FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE**  
**AND ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of Harrison Williams and Pine Knob Estate Water, Inc.'s August 26, 2021 application for a water utility stock transfer under 16 TAC § 24.243. On September 30, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application and notice.


The administrative law judge finds the application is administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.8(b).

By October 14, 2021, the applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in Leila Guerrero's September 30, 2021 memorandum. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed.

By October 28, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
