
**ORDER NO. 13  
REQUIRING STATUS REPORT**

This Order addresses the need for a status report from the parties. On September 5, 2023, Harrison Williams filed a response to Order No. 11 and requested continued abatement of this docket for 120 days. Mr. Williams advised that the additional 120 days would be sufficient time for the completion of a new water well. The administrative law judge (ALJ) granted that request and continued the abatement.

The ALJ notes that this docket has been abated for over two years and is reluctant to continue the abatement of this proceeding. Therefore, by March 12, 2024, the parties must file a status report and a proposed procedural schedule. If the parties request continued abatement, the ALJ requires the parties to show good cause why abatement is warranted.
