ORDER NO. 15
FINDING PETITION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE
AND ESTABLISHING OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the September 9, 2021 petition filed by Brent Davis to revoke certificate of convenience and necessity number 12498.

On March 26, 2024, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the administrative complete of the petition.


The administrative law judge finds the petition administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider the petition filed until it makes a determination that the petition is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the petition is not considered filed with the Commission.

By April 26, 2024, Mr. Davis must supplement the petition to cure the deficiencies described in the March 26, 2024 memorandum of Patricia Garcia which is attached to Commission Staff's recommendation. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the petition cannot proceed. The petitioner must not issue notice until the petition is found administratively complete.

By May 28, 2024, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the petition, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
