SOAH ORDER NO. 2
MEMORIALIZING PREHEARING CONFERENCE;
GRANTING MOTION TO INTERVENE; AND REQUIRING FILING

I. PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On January 4, 2022, Administrative Law Judge Ross Henderson convened a prehearing conference in this matter via the Zoom videoconferencing platform. The following parties appeared: Southwestern Public Service Company, represented by Mark Santos; Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas, represented by Mildred Anaele; Office of Public Utility Counsel (OPUC), represented by Tucker Furlow; Sierra Club, represented by Matthew Miller; Texas Industrial Energy Consumers, represented by Benjamin Hallmark; and Alliance of Xcel Municipalities, represented by Sergio Herrera.

II. GRANTING MOTION TO INTERVENE


OPUC filed a Motion to Intervene in this matter on December 13, 2021. No party has filed a response in opposition to this Motion and no party opposed the Motion at the prehearing conference. The Motion is **GRANTED**.

III. REQUIRING FILING

A proposed procedural schedule was discussed at the prehearing conference. The parties agreed that no more than 3 days were required to conduct a hearing for this matter. The parties also agreed that each was available the last week of April 2022 to conduct the hearing. Finally, the

parties agreed that after the conclusion of the prehearing conference, they would confer and submit an agreed procedural schedule or competing schedules consistent with holding a hearing the last week of April 2022. Therefore, the parties are **ORDERED** to confer and submit a proposed procedural schedule or competing schedules no later than January 11, 2022.
