**ORDER NO. 3  
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by SWWC Utilities, Inc. dba Hornsby Bend Utility Company, Inc. On November 29, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding notice and proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing.

On November 3, 2021, SWWC Utilities filed (1) the affidavit of Brian Bahr, SWWC Utilities' authorized representative, attesting that notice of the application, along with a map of the requested service area, was sent to current customers, landowners, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on November 2, 2021; and (2) a publisher's affidavit attesting to publication of notice in *The Austin Chronicle*, a newspaper of general circulation in Travis, Hays, and Williamson counties on October 22 and 29, 2021.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient.

The following procedural schedule is established for continued processing:
