REQUIRING RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY OF CLOSING DOCUMENTS  
AND A PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On April 20 and 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022, the applicants filed their proof of closing documents and addressed customer deposits. Per Ordering Paragraph 7 of Order No. 6, filed March 21, 2022, The Commission Staff was required to within 15 days of the filing of applicants' proof that the transaction has been consummated and customer deposits, if any, have been addressed, file a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the documents and propose a schedule for continued processing.

Commission Staff is directed to file its recommendation on the sufficiency of the closing documents by May 31, 2022, along with a procedural schedule for continuing processing.
