**ORDER NO. 2**  
**FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,**  
**REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the September 1, 2021 application of R & N Enterprises and Monarch Utilities I, LP for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Cooke County. On October 1, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation of the sufficiency the application.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner described in and attached to Jolie Mathis' memoranda dated September 28, 2021, using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:
