**ORDER NO. 34**  
**ESTABLISHING DEADLINE FOR ADDITIONAL ITEMS**

In Order No. 33 filed on April 25, 2024, the administrative law judge (ALJ) determined that Undine, LLC's requests for good cause to waive the notice requirements in 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(d)(2)(A) would be addressed in a subsequent order. Commission Staff did not oppose the requests. Additionally, as a part of Order No. 32, the parties were required to file a corrected certificate of convenience and necessity for Undine and move for additional items to be admitted into the record on or before May 17, 2024. As of the date of this Order, no filings have been made.

On or before June 17, 2024, the parties must file the corrected certificate of convenience and necessity and move for additional items to be admitted into evidence as described in and required by Order Nos. 32 and 33.
