**ORDER NO. 21**  
**FINDING REVISED NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND REQUIRING PROPOSED**  
**PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the revised notice provided by Texas Water Systems, Inc. and Undine Development, LLC (collectively, applicants) regarding the application for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Gregg, Henderson, Smith, and Upshur counties.

On February 22, 2023, the applicants filed the affidavit of Carey Thomas, senior vice president of Undine, attesting that notice, along with maps, was mailed to current customers, landowners, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on February 15, 2023.


On March 17, 2023, the applicants filed a publisher's affidavit attesting that notice was published in the *Longview News-Journal*, a newspaper of general circulation in Gregg County, on February 10 and 17, 2023; a publisher's affidavit attesting that notice was published in the *Tyler Morning Telegraph*, a newspaper of general circulation in Smith County, on February 10 and 17, 2023; and a publisher's affidavit attesting that notice was published in *The Gilmer Mirror*, a newspaper of general circulation in Upshur County, on February 16 and 23, 2023.

On April 4, 2023, Commission Staff filed, among other things, a recommendation regarding revised notice.

The administrative law judge finds the revised notice sufficient. By April 28, 2023, the parties must file a proposed procedural schedule for continued processing of this application.
